Joel Wym an Collins, Jr. (Joe-Too) is a familiar name in Chester. His father, Joel Wym an Collins became the coach at Chester High after the family moved here in 1948. Joe's is the story of a Chester boy doing well—very, very well. He's coming back to Chester for this very special event.

He's a Clemson graduate, and a graduate of the University of South Carolina School of Law. He's served in the Judge Advocate General Corps of the U.S. Army, eventually returning to Columbia to establish his own law firm.
