Twenty years of research into archival and Confederate records enabled me to discover the names of more than 3,000 South Carolina Confederate soldiers who died in the War but have never been recorded in earlier, formal chronicles. The last several years have been spent organizing the known and new soldiers into book form for publishing. Titled "And Were the Glory of Their Times," the series consists of the South Carolina artillery service (848 pages), presently available, with the cavalry (886 pages) available in January 2015 and the infantry (several volumes) by approximately June 2016. The volumes are comprehensive, naming the known and the new and provide a biographical/genealogical sketch of the majority of the soldiers.
