This The Gunnison Toilet Bathroom Building was installed here at the Old Zion Cemetery and Heritage Site at Halsellville on Friday, May 24, 2019 at a cost of \$23,706.00. The Herbert and Anna Lutz's Foundation of Chester provided a grant to the Old Zion St. Paul Halsellville Cemetery Association (OZSPHCA) on January 7, 2019, in the amount of \$15,000 to assist in funding the facility. The members of the OZSPHCA provided the remainder of the cost. The Herbert and Anna Lutz's Foundation members visited the Old Zion Cemetery and Heritage Site on Monday, June 17, 2019. They inspected the facility and received a briefing and final report on the grant from James E. "Jimmy" Wright, President of OZSPHCA. Wright conveyed to the members of The Herbert and Anna Lutz's Foundation the OZSPHCA's deep gratitude and appreciation for The Foundation's major contribution in helping to underwrite the cost of this needed enhancement at the Old Zion Cemetery and Heritage Site.

One of the Founding Members of OZSPHCA Passes at 92 Mr. (Uncle) Havies Wilkes, Sr., September 21, 1926 – March 15, 2019

Occasionally in life our paths intersect with people who are inspirational giants. So it was with Havies Wilkes, Sr. He was one of earliest supporters of the restoration work at Old Zion and an organizing member of the Old Zion St. Paul Halsellville Cemetery Association (OZSPHCA). Uncle Havies and "Mrs. Elizabeth" were faithful in attending each early organizational meeting. It was Uncle Havies' parliamentary motion that led to the formal organization of the OZSPHCA.

Mr. Havies Wilkes, Sr. passed away on March 15, 2019 at the Tucker Hospice House in Kannapolis, North Carolina. Funeral Service was held at the Marable A. M. E. Zion Church in Kannapolis on Saturday, March 23, 2019.

As a former member of the Old Zion A. M. E. Zion Church with deep family roots and ties, Uncle Havies was a valuable source of information on the history and people of this sacred place of worship here at Halsellville. He graced us with his enthusiastic presence and smile at each **Annual Revival Reunion/Camp Meeting** on "The Third Sunday in September." His "Wilkes Family" was always the single largest family group at each Annual gathering. We always looked forward with great joy to their arrival "from Kannapolis." *Uncle Havies' Fish Fry* was the "big hit" and the **Seventh (7th) Annual Revival Reunion/Camp Meeting (2017)**. Due to his illness, he was not able to attend the **2018 Annual Revival Reunion.**
